

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ALVA, WOODS COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Value Added Products, a closed cooperative, the owner of the following described land now owned by it and now adjoining the City of Alva, Oklahoma, has given written consent that said land be annexed to said City and become a part of the territory included within the corporate limits of said City, said land and premises being described in said consent, and hereinafter particularly described; and

WHEREAS, the above-named owner owns a majority of the area to be annexed to the City of Alva, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Mayor and Council of the City of Alva, that said land should be annexed to the City of Alva, Oklahoma;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALVA, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION ONE: That all of certain pieces and parcels of land now adjoining the City of Alva, and bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

A Tract of Land Lying in the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Twenty-seven (27) North, Range Fourteen (14) W.I.M., City of Alva, Woods County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as beginning at a point on the South section line 650.00 Feet West along and following the South section line on an assigned bearing of S 90° W from the Southeast corner of said Section Twenty-six (26), thence 120.00 Feet continuing to follow the South section line bearing S 90° W, thence 646.20 Feet bearing N 00° 16' 05" W parallel the East section line, thence 120.00 Feet bearing N 90° E, thence 646.20 Feet bearing S 00° 16' 95" E, said tract containing 1.78 acres more or less,

be and the same are hereby annexed to and shall hereafter be a part of the territory included within the corporate limits of the City of Alva, Woods County, Oklahoma.

SECTION TWO: It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Alva, Oklahoma, that this ordinance be passed without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
