ORDINANCE NO. 83-10-1

BEING AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BARNSDALL, OSAGE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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WHEREAS, certain tracts of land lying and being situated in Osage County, Oklahoma, and adjacent to the City of Barnsdall, described in Section 1 hereof;

WHEREAS, a consent, signed by the sole owners of the aforesaid tract has been filed with the City of Barnsdall, consenting that said property be annexed by the said City and the City limits extended to include said tract, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable and for the best interest of the inhabitants of said tract and the City of Barnsdall that the corporate limits of said City be extended to include said tract.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Barnsdall as follows:

Section 1.

That the corporate limits of the City of Barnsdall, Osage County, Oklahoma, be, and the same are hereby extended so as to include real estate contiguous to the City and situated in Osage County, Oklahoma, described as follows:

A strip of land, being 5.0 feet in width, across a part of Section 17 and Section 18, Township 24 North, Range 11 East of the I.B. & M., Osage County, State of Oklahoma, said strip of land being described from a base line (said width being 5.0 feet left of said base line and 0.00 feet right). Said base line being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the North right-of-way of Oklahoma Highway 11 and the South boundary of the Original Townsite of Barnsdall (Bigheart), Oklahoma, Thence Southeasterly along said North right-of-way of Oklahoma State Highway 11 to the Intersection of the West right-of-way of Oklahoma State Highway 123, Thence Northerly along said West right-of-way of Oklahoma Highway 123 to a point 51.03 feet North of the South line of the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of said Section 17, Thence N 89° 49' E to a point on the North right-of-way of county road (as recorded in Book 3, Page 358), said point being 1160.0 feet S 89° 49' W from the East line of the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of said Section 17, thence N 00° 11' W a distance of 440.0 feet to a point, Thence S 89° 49' W a distance of 990.0 feet to a point, Thence S 00° 11' E a distance of 429.0 feet to a point 11.0 feet North of said right-of-way of county road (as recorded in Book 3, Page 358), Thence S 89° 49' W to a point 11.0 feet West of said West right-of-way of Oklahoma State Highway 123, Thence Southerly and parallel with said West right-of-way of Oklahoma State Highway 123 to the North Boundary line of Ethel Reese Cemetery, Thence Southwesterly along said North boundary of Ethel Reese Cemetery to the Northwest corner of said cemetery, Thence Southerly along West boundary of said Ethel Reese Cemetery to a point 11.0 feet North of the North right-of-way of State Highway 11, Thence Northwesterly and parallel with said North right-of-way of Oklahoma Highway 11 to a point on the South boundary of said Original Townsite of Barnsdall (Bigheart) Oklahoma.

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Section 2.

Emergency Clause. By reason of the facts above mentioned and for the purpose of protecting the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Barnsdall, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

PASSED, APPROVED and the emergency clause acted upon separately this 4<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1983.
