AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLACKWELL, OKLAHOMA, DETACHING CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BLACKWELL; AMENDING THE OFFICIAL PLAN AND MAP ACCORDINGLY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Blackwell, Oklahoma has investigated and determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City that the land described below be detached from the corporate limits of said City, such detachment to result in creating a more uniform boundary for the city limits, a reduction of City streets and alley maintenance, clarification of police protection duties, reduction of code enforcement responsibilities and a reduction of the flood plain management area of said City. By reason thereof, and in accordance with Title 11 O. S., §21-110, the described property should be detached from the corporate limits of the City of Blackwell, Oklahoma, and the official city plan and map should be amended accordingly.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BLACKWELL, OKLAHOMA, that the following described tract of land be detached from the corporate limits of the City of Blackwell, Oklahoma, and said property shall be removed from the official city plan and map of the City of Blackwell, said tract being more fully described as follows:

Blocks 40 and 41, Parker Addition to the City of Blackwell, Kay county, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, together with that portion of East College Avenue lying East of a line running parallel to the West right-of-way line of "I" Street and connecting the Northwest corner of Block 50 to the Southwest corner of Block 41, all in Parker Addition to the City of Blackwell; and that portion of East Padon Avenue lying East of a line running parallel to the West right-of-way line of "I" Street and connecting the Northwest corner of Block 41 to the Southwest corner of Block 20, all in Parker Addition to the City of Blackwell, as the same is set forth in the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the matters contained in this Ordinance do pertain to the public peace, health, safety and property of the citizens of the City of Blackwell and that therefore an emergency is declared and determined to exist whereby this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
