

**ORDINANCE NO. 2510**

An ordinance annexing certain contiguous tracts of land in Section 19, Township 18 North, Range 15 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Wagoner County, Oklahoma, to the city limits of the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, granting a zoning classification, adopting a service plan, and declaring an emergency. This land is generally at 9625 South 193<sup>rd</sup> East Avenue on the east side of County Line Road and roughly 1/2 mile south of Washington (91<sup>st</sup> Street).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BROKEN ARROW CITY COUNCIL:

SECTION I: That the following described tracts of land lying adjacent to the present corporate limits of the City of Broken Arrow, to-wit:

A part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 19, Township 18 North, Range 15 East, in Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma, commencing at the S/W corner of said Section; thence North 2,172.00' to the Point of Beginning; thence North 140.43'; thence East 329.14'; thence South 140.43'; thence West 329.14' to the Point of Beginning according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof,

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, and the corporate limits of said City are hereby extended to include the above-described tract of land. After the effective date of this ordinance, all property located therein, and all persons residing or otherwise occupying the land shall be subject to the jurisdiction of this City and all laws made pursuant thereto. All tracts of land shall be assigned AR-E zoning.

City Council expressly finds that all requirements of 110.S. §21-103 have been fully complied with in advance of the issuance of this ordinance. The zoning classification on this land is hereby changed to AR-E as set out above.


SECTION II: Police, fire and zoning services shall be extended immediately upon annexation. The street and utility construction and maintenance will be completed in accordance with existing construction standards and the normal development process.

SECTION III: An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.

PASSED AND APPROVED, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately this 6<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2003.


