

ORDINANCE NO. 2637

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An ordinance annexing certain contiguous tracts of land in Sections 19 and 29, Township 19 North, Range 15 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Wagoner County, Oklahoma, to the city limits of the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, granting a zoning classification, adopting a service plan, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BROKEN ARROW CITY COUNCIL:

SECTION 1: That the following described tracts of land lying adjacent to the present corporate limits of the City of Broken Arrow, to-wit:

The Northwest quarter (NW/4), less and except the northerly and westerly 24.75 feet thereof previously annexed; and the Southeast quarter (SE/4), less and except the easterly and southerly 24.75 feet thereof previously annexed; all of Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 15 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma according to the U.S. Government survey thereof.

AND

The Southeast quarter (SE/4), less and except the easterly 24.75 feet thereof previously annexed, of Section 29, Township 19 North, Range 15 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma according to the U.S. Government survey thereof,

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, and the corporate limits of said City are hereby extended to include the above-described tract of land. After the effective date of this ordinance, all property located therein, and all persons residing or otherwise occupying the land shall be subject to the jurisdiction of this City and all laws made pursuant thereto. City Council expressly finds that all requirements of 110.S. §21-103 have been fully complied with in advance of the issuance of this ordinance. The zoning classification on this land is hereby changed to A-1; provided that the platted subdivisions of Glen Eagles and Glen Eagles II Additions are hereby granted the zoning classification of AR-3S.

SECTION II: Police, fire and zoning services shall be extended immediately upon annexation. The street and utility construction and maintenance will be completed in accordance with existing construction standards and the normal development process. The Service Plan is incorporated by reference.

SECTION III: An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.

PASSED AND APPROVED and the emergency clause ruled upon separately this 21<sup>st</sup> day of June, 2004.


