

ORDINANCE NO. 2824

An ordinance annexing Lot 7, Block 1, Timberbrook I Subdivision, Wagoner County, Oklahoma into the city limits of the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, granting a zoning classification; and establishing an effective date of November 8, 2006.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BROKEN ARROW CITY COUNCIL:

Section I: That the following described tract of land lying adjacent to the present corporate limits of the City of Broken Arrow, to-wit:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

Lot 7, Block 1, Timberbrook I, a subdivision of part of the NW/4 SE/4 and SW/4 NE/4 of Section 5, Township 18 North, Range 15 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof.

be and the same is hereby annexed into the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, and the corporate limits of said City are hereby extended to include the above-described tract of land. After the effective date of this ordinance, all property located therein, and all persons residing or otherwise occupying the land shall be subject to the jurisdiction of this City and all laws made pursuant thereto. The City council expressly finds that all requirements of 11 O.S. §21-103 have been fully complied with in advance of the issuance of this ordinance. As such, the zoning classification on this land is hereby changed to AR-1.

Section II: Police, fire and zoning services shall be extended immediately upon the effective date of annexation.

Section III: This ordinance shall become effective on November 8, 2006.


