

ORDINANCE NO. 2840

An ordinance annexing Lots One (1) and Two (2) in the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Section 1, Township 17 North, Range 14 East of the Indian Meridian, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma into to the city limits of the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, granting a zoning classification; repealing all ordinances to the contrary; and declaring an emergency.



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BROKEN ARROW CITY COUNCIL:

Section I: That the following described tract of land lying adjacent to the present corporate limits of the City of Broken Arrow, to-wit:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

Lots One (1) and Two (2) in the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Section 1, Township 17 North, Range 14 East of the Indian Meridian, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof.

be and the same is hereby annexed into the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, and the corporate limits of said City are hereby extended to include the above-described tract of land. After the effective date of this ordinance, all property located therein, and all persons residing or otherwise occupying the land shall be subject to the jurisdiction of this City and all laws made pursuant thereto. The City council expressly finds that all requirements of 11 O.S. §21-103 have been fully complied with in advance of the issuance of this ordinance. As such, the zoning classification on this land is hereby changed to A-1.

Section II: Police, fire and zoning services shall be extended immediately upon the effective date of annexation.

Section III: Any ordinances or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section IV: An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.

PASSED AND APPROVED and the Emergency Clause ruled upon separately this 18th day of December, 2006.
