

ORDINANCE NO. 383

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW, OKLAHOMA, EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW, OKLAHOMA, DESIGNATING THE WARD WHICH SAID PROPERTY SHALL BECOME PART OF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the City of Broken Bow desires to extend the corporate limits of the City of Broken Bow, Oklahoma.

Whereas, the City of Broken Bow has obtained the written consent of the owners of at least a majority of the acres to be annexed to the municipality and provided for notice and a public hearing on the proposed annexation of the territory in the manner provided in 11 OSA 21-103 (B).

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the council for the City of Broken Bow, Oklahoma:

Section 1: That the corporate limits of the City of Broken Bow, Oklahoma are extended so far as to include all property contained in the following real property:


