ORDINANCE NO. 2013-05-01

**AN ORDINANCE DECREASING THE LIMITS OF
THE TOWN OF CADDO, OKLAHOMA, BY DETACHING
PROPERTY WEST OF: 1) THE SOUTHBOUND ENTRANCE
RAMP OF UNITED STATES HIGHWAY 75 SOUTHBOUND; 2)
INTERSECTING STATE HIGHWAY 22; AND 3) UNITED STATES
HIGHWAY 75 SOUTHBOUND EXIT RAMP INTERSECTING STATE
HIGHWAY 22; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Town of Caddo (the "Town") previously adopted an ordinance which annexed a portion of right of way beginning from United States Highway 75 Southbound entrance to onto ramp, and United States Highway 75 Southbound exit onto State Highway 22 and extending West along State Highway 22 to Cat City Road to the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town have determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to detach the property West of: 1) the Southbound entrance ramp of United States Highway 75 Southbound; 2) intersecting State Highway 22; and 3) United States Highway 75 Southbound exit ramp intersecting State Highway 22 (the "Property") from the Town; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to OKLA. STAT. tit. 11 § 21-110, publishing of notice and holding a public hearing are not required for a detachment by ordinance by the Town; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CADDO, OKLAHOMA:

Section No. 1: That the Property be detached from the corporate limits of the Town of Caddo, Oklahoma, pursuant to the authority granted to the Board of Trustees of the Town of Caddo, Oklahoma, by OKLA. STAT. tit. 11 § 21-110 (A) (1).

Section No. 2: That the Town Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to cause this ordinance to be published as required by law.

Section No. 3: That the Mayor is hereby ordered and directed to file and record this ordinance and the other documents as required by OKLA. STAT. tit. 11, § 21-112, with the Bryan County Clerk and the Ad Valorem Division of the Oklahoma Tax Commission.

Section No. 4: An emergency is hereby deemed and declared to exist whereby it is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Caddo, Oklahoma, that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and adoption.

Passed and Approved by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Caddo, Oklahoma, this 4th day of March, 2013, by vote on Section Nos. 1, 2 & 3, and then by separate vote on Section 4 (Emergency Clause).
