AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY TO THE TOWN OF CANUTE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Canute held a public hearing on October 9, 2001, at 6:00 p.m. in the Town Hall in Canute, Oklahoma to determine whether to annex the real property described herein; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees for the Town of Canute also determined at said public hearing what town services would be provided to said real property; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees for the Town of Canute determined that it would be in the best interest of the Town of Canute to annex said real property.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CANUTE, OKLAHOMA:

**Section 1.** The owners of the hereinafter described property, having requested in writing that the following described property be annexed to the Town of Canute, Washita County, State of Oklahoma; and that the Trustees for the Town of Canute, Oklahoma, have voted unanimously to extend the corporate limits of the Town of Canute to include the real property described below which is adjacent to and abutting upon the existing corporate limits of the Town of Canute and that said real property is hereby annexed to the Town of Canute, Oklahoma:

Surface Only In and To:

A tract in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE/4 SW/4) of Section 13, Township 11 North, Range 20 W.I.M., Washita County, Oklahoma, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest Corner of said SE/4SW/4; thence South along the West boundary of said SE/4SW/4 a distance of 363.43 feet to a point on the Northerly right-of-way of Interstate Highway 40 North access road; thence South 60°25' East along said right-of-way a distance of 180 feet; thence South 64°32' East along said right-of-way a distance of 59.21 feet; thence North a distance of 475.46 feet to a point on the North boundary of said SE/4SW/4; thence North 89°18' West along said North boundary for a distance of 210 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.02 acres more or less; and

Surface Only In and To:

The South Half of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (S/2S/2SE/4SE/4) of Section 13, Township 11 North, Range 20 W.I.M., Washita County, Oklahoma,

**Section 3.** It being necessary for the protection and preservation of the public peace and safety of the residents of the Town of Canute, this Ordinance is hereby classified as an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE, and the same is hereby declared an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.


