

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA
EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID TOWN, AND
DESIGNATING THE CONTIGUOUS TRACT INCLUDED IN SUCH
EXTENSION: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the tract of land hereinbelow designated (known as the Pennington Addition) has been determined by the Carnegie, Oklahoma, Town Board of Trustees to be, by definition, adjacent and contiguous to the present corporate limits of said Town; and

WHEREAS, said tract of land has been subdivided into parcels of less than five (5) acres each; and

WHEREAS, said tract currently contains more than one (1) residence; and

WHEREAS, all residents of the said Addition have agreed to said annexation, with none in opposition, and, therefore, public hearing and service plan requirements are not in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Carnegie, Oklahoma:


SECTION 1. Carnegie Corporate Limits Extended.

Consistent with the purposes incorporated in the Town's adopted Annexation Policy Resolution, the corporate limits of the Town of Carnegie, Oklahoma, are hereby extended, in accordance with 11 O.S. 1986 Supplement, Section 21-103, to include the tract of land known as the Pennington Addition (according to the plat filed in the Caddo County Courthouse and as shown on the attached map), comprising 5.03 acres, more or less.

Section 2. Emergency.

It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Carnegie, Oklahoma, that the hereindescribed tract of land be annexed to said Town, as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared, by reason whereof the terms of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval, adoption and publication, as required by Law.






