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ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE ENLARGING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF CASHION, OKLAHOMA, BY ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED IN LOT SEVEN, SECTION SIX, TOWNSHIP FIFTEEN NORTH, RANGE FOUR WEST, LOGAN COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, AS MORE FULLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CASHION:

Section 1. Jurisdiction. The Board of Trustees finds that the sole owner of the property herein described has petitioned for annexation to the Town of Cashion, Oklahoma, and notice of presentment of said petition has been published as required by 11 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 34-101.

2. Annexation. The following-described property in Logan County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract of land describe as a part of a tract of land lying in Government Lot 7, of Section 6, Township 15 North, Range 4 West of the Indian Meridian, Logan County, described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of said Government Lot 7; thence North 89°26'10" East along the South line of said Government Lot 7, a distance of 517 feet; thence North 0°33'50" West perpendicular to said South line a distance of 611.94 feet to a point on South line of 20 acre tract presently owned by Cashion School; thence West perpendicular to West line of said Government Lot 7 a distance of 510.95 feet to a point on West line of Government Lot 7; thence South along said West line a distance of 617 feet to the point of beginning, containing 7.25 acres more or less; said tract being subject to State Highway 74F right-of-way along the West and South sides of described tract; (surface rights only); more particularly described as beginning at the Southwest Corner of the above-described tract, then North 177 feet, then East 170 feet, then South 177 feet, then West 170 feet to the point of beginning;

is hereby annexed and made a part of the corporate limits of the Town of Cashion, Oklahoma.

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3. The Town Board hereby authorizes the Cashion Public Works Authority to extend water, sewer, and gas service to the subject

property upon payment by the owners of the required tap fees and deposits.

4. The Town Clerk is directed to record a copy of this ordinance in the Offices of the Logan and Kingfisher County Clerks with a map attached showing the annexed area.

5. Repealer. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

6. Severability. If any part, article, section, or subsection of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance, notwithstanding such holding.


7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on May 1, 1992.





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
