

ORDINANCE NO. 84

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED IN SECTION 7, T15N, R4W, I.M., LOGAN COUNTY, AS MORE SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED HEREINAFTER TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF CASHION, OKLAHOMA; PROVIDING FOR JURISDICTIONAL FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CASHION:

Section 1. Jurisdictional Findings. Whereas, at least three-fourths (3/4) of the registered voters and the owners of at least three-fourths (3/4) in value of the hereinafter described lands have petitioned the Town of Cashion, Oklahoma, to annex the described property into the corporate limits of Cashion; and,

WHEREAS, notice of presentation and notice of hearing were published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Cashion, Oklahoma, once a week for two consecutive weeks with the hearing being held more than two weeks following the first publication; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees determine it is desirable and feasible to annex the property into the Town of Cashion, Oklahoma.

Section 2. Annexation. The following-described property is hereby annexed to the Town of Cashion, Oklahoma, and included within the corporate limits thereof:

Property in Logan County, Oklahoma;

South Half (S/2) of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Seven (7), Township Fifteen North (T15N), Range Four West (R4W), I.M.; less the West 33 feet.

Section 3. Publication. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to publish this ordinance in the Logan County Newspaper and to record a copy of this ordinance and the map of such annexation with the County Clerk of Logan County, Oklahoma.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances on conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability. If any part, article, section, or subsection of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance, notwithstanding such holding.



It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Town of Cashion and the inhabitants thereof that this ordinance be put into full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.




