

ORDINANCE NO. 87

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED IN SECTION ONE, TOWNSHIP FIFTEEN NORTH, RANGE ONE WEST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN, KINGFISHER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, AND SECTION SIX, TOWNSHIP FIFTEEN NORTH, RANGE FOUR WEST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN, LOGAN COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, AS MORE SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED HEREINAFTER, TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF CASHION, OKLAHOMA; PROVIDING FOR JURISDICTIONAL FINDINGS; ADOPTING A REVISED SERVICE PLAN; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CASHION, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. Jurisdictional Findings. WHEREAS, the hereinafter described property lies adjacent to the corporate limits of the Town of Cashion, Oklahoma, and the Town of Cashion has proposed a plan to extend Town services to the area proposed to be annexed; and,

WHEREAS, notice of proposed annexation and notice of hearing were published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Cashion, Oklahoma, with the hearing being held more than fourteen (14) days following the first publication; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees determine it desirable and feasible to annex the property into the Town of Cashion, Oklahoma.

Section 2. Annexation. The following-described property is hereby annexed to the Town of Cashion, Oklahoma, and included within the corporate limits thereof:

Property in Kingfisher County, Oklahoma:

Beginning at the Southeast (SE) corner of Block Twelve (12), Beadles Addition to Cashion, Oklahoma, thence South 230 feet, thence East 720 feet, thence North 910 feet, thence West 462.3 feet, thence South 680 feet, thence West 257.7 feet, to the point of beginning, being a part of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section One (1), Township Fifteen (15) North, Range Five (5) West, I.M.;

Property in Logan County, Oklahoma:

A Twenty (20) acre tract in Lot Seven (7), and the Southeast Quarter (SE/4), Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of said Section.

Section 3. Publication. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to publish this ordinance in the Kingfisher County Newspaper and Logan County Newspaper, and to record a copy of this ordinance and the map of such annexation with the County Clerk of Kingfisher County and Logan County.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances on conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability. If any part, article, section, or subsection of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance, notwithstanding such holding.

Section 6. Emergency. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Town of Cashion and the inhabitants thereof that this ordinance be put into full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


