

ORDINANCE NUMBER 295-A

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF CATOOSA,  
OKLAHOMA, TRACT OF LAND

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of October, 1997, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of the City of Catoosa, Oklahoma, did by its' motion vote to annex into the corporate limits of the said City of Catoosa, Oklahoma, certain tracts land, described as follows, to-wit:

TRACT A:

A tract of land in Lot Four (4) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Fifteen (15) East, of the I.B. & M., according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point 211 feet North of the Southwest corner of Lot Four (4), thence East 100 feet, thence North parallel to the West line of Lot Four (4) a distance of 552.3 feet, thence Northerly on a curve to the right having a radius of 473.7 feet, a distance of 187 feet, thence North 22° 05' East to the North line of Lot Four (4), thence along the North line of Lot Four (4) to the Northwest corner of Lot Four (4), thence South to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, it appears that under the laws made and provided by the State of Oklahoma in such cases said land hereinabove described may be lawfully annexed to the City of Catoosa, Rogers County, Oklahoma, and henceforth, for all purposes considered a part of said City, and,

WHEREAS, an accurate map of the area for which annexation is sought has been filed with the City Council of said City of Catoosa, which map is duly certified by the Mayor, the Presiding Officer of the City Council of said City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Catoosa, Oklahoma, in regular session duly assembled as follows:

SECTION 1: That the following land be and hereby is annexed to the City of Catoosa, Oklahoma, all of said land being situated in Rogers County, Oklahoma, to-wit: BOOK 1000 PAGE 037?

TRACT A:

A tract of land in Lot Four (4) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Fifteen (15) East, of the I.B. & M., according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point 211 feet North of the Southwest corner of Lot Four (4), thence East 100 feet, thence North parallel to the West line of Lot Four (4) a distance of 552.3 feet, thence Northerly on a curve to the right having a radius of 473.7 feet, a distance of 187 feet, thence North 22° 05' East to the North line of Lot Four (4), thence along the North line of Lot Four (4) to the Northwest corner of Lot Four (4), thence South to the point of beginning.

SECTION 4: ~~That the zoning classification in Rogers County for Tract "A" was AG and shall be zoned C-4 in the City of Catoosa.~~

SECTION 5: That there be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Rogers County, Oklahoma, a true and correct copy of this ordinance, together with an accurate map of the territory hereby annexed.

SECTION 6: EMERGENCY

It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after passage, approval and publication.
