

ORDINANCE NO. 2000- 02

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF CHOUTEAU, OKLAHOMA, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a municipal governing body by ordinance may add to the municipality territory adjacent or contiguous to its corporate limits and increase or diminish the corporate limits as the governing body deems desirable for the benefit of the municipality;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Chouteau, Oklahoma (the "Board"), proposes to annex certain territory into the corporate limits of the Town of Chouteau, Oklahoma (the "Town"), pursuant to the specific provisions of Title 11, §§ 21-101 and 21-104, and for the reasons set forth herein;

WHEREAS, there has been an increased flow of traffic and a corresponding increase in traffic accidents in, upon and around the territory proposed for annexation herein, said conditions creating the need for this annexation;

WHEREAS, by Resolution the Town Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the Town of Chouteau, Oklahoma (the "Town"), has proposed to annex certain territory into the Town's corporate limits, said territory being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land in both the SE/4, SW/4 and the SW/4, SE/4 of Section 36, T20N, R18E of the Indian Base and Meridian in Mayes County, Oklahoma; more particularly described as the full width of the original right-of-way of Highway 69 extending from the northwest corner of the SW/4, SE/4 of said Section 36 to a point 16.5 feet south of the southwest corner of the SW/4, SE/4 of said Section 36. Said tract containing 3.0 acres more or less assuming an original highway 69 right-of-way width of 100 feet for the full north-south length of the tract.

WHEREAS, the proposed territory is adjacent and contiguous to the Town;

WHEREAS, the Board has adopted a plan for servicing said territory;

WHEREAS, the Board has caused all notices to be sent and publications to be published as required by statute;

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of May, 2000, the Board conducted a public hearing on said annexation proposal wherein exhibits were entered into the record and where no one appeared to contest or comment on said annexation proposal;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that all the requisites to annexing the territory have been satisfied and met, all as required by law;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined it to be in the best interest of the Town to annex the aforementioned territory;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CHOUTEAU, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1: That, pursuant to the laws made and provided by the State of Oklahoma the real property hereinafter described may be lawfully annexed to the Town and, henceforth for all purposes, considered a part of the Town.

Section 2: That the following described real property and premises, situated in Mayes County, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby annexed to the Town of Chouteau, Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract of land in both the SE/4, SW/4 and the SW/4, SE/4 of Section 36, T20N, R18E of the Indian Base and Meridian in Mayes County, Oklahoma; more particularly described as the full width of the original right-of-way of Highway 69 extending from the northwest corner of the SW/4, SE/4 of said Section 36 to a point 16.5 feet south of the southwest corner of the SW/4, SE/4 of said Section 36. Said tract containing 3.0 acres more or less assuming an original highway 69 right-of-way width of 100 feet for the full north-south length of the tract.

Section 3: That there shall be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Mayes County, Oklahoma, a true and certified copy of this Ordinance, together with an accurate map of the territory hereby annexed.

Section 4: That the Service Plan attached hereto as Exhibit "A" be and the same is hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance.


