AN ORDINANCE DETACHING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY FROM THE CITY OF CLAREMORE, OKLAHOMA, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF CLAREMORE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The City of Claremore, Oklahoma, hereby deems it desirable for the benefit of the municipality to detach certain real property within its corporate city limits.

Section 2. The City of Claremore, Oklahoma hereby finds that the real property to be detached may be lawfully detached from the City and, henceforth, for all purposes, unless or until again annexed by the City, shall not be a part of the corporate limits of the City.

Section 3. The following described real property and premises in Rogers County, Oklahoma, is hereby detached from the City of Claremore, Oklahoma, to wit:

A strip piece or parcel described as follows:

The South 1.00 feet of Section 19; and,
The West 1.00 feet of the South 1.00 feet of Section 20; and,
The West 1.00 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4 of NW/4) of Section 29; and,
The South 1.00 feet of the East 1.00 feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE/4 of NE/4) of Section 30; and,
The East 1.00 feet of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE/4 of NE/4) of Section 30, lying North of the Will Rogers Turnpike right-of-way,
All in Township 21 North, Range 16 East of the I. B. & M., Rogers County, Oklahoma, according to the U. S. Government survey thereof.


Section 4. The Mayor shall file and record, or cause to be filed and recorded, a duly certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map or plat of the territory detached, in the office of the county clerk of Rogers County, Oklahoma and with the Ad Valorem Tax Division of the Oklahoma Tax Commission.

Section 5. **EMERGENCY** It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.




