

ORDINANCE NO. 834

**AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA,
A TRACT OF LAND SITUATED IN LOT FOUR OF SECTION TWO, TOWNSHIP
ELEVEN NORTH, RANGE SEVENTEEN WEST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN
(2-11-17), WASHITA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, deems it proper to annex the tract of land hereinbelow described and that such annexation will rebound to the benefit of said City of Clinton, and

WHEREAS, the owners of a majority of the land lying within the area proposed for annexation have given consent to the City of Clinton that the subject property be annexed by and to the City of Clinton, and thereby made a part of the land area within the corporate boundaries of the City of Clinton, and

WHEREAS, subject property is hereby described as:

A tract of land in Lot 4 of Section 2, Township 11 North, Range 17, W.I.M (2-11-17) Washita County, Oklahoma described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the north boundary line (BL) of said Lot 4 of Section 2, T11N-R17WIM, Washita County, Oklahoma and the new east right-of-way (R/W) line of US 183 said point bearing S 89°15'46"E~141.07 feet from the northwest corner (NWc) of said Lot 4: THENCE S89°15'46"E~292.47 feet along said north BL to the NWc of a tract Presently owned by James Green; THENCE S 00° 47' 17"W~473.00 feet along the West BL of said Green tract; THENCE N 89° 15'46"W~ 291.61 feet to a point on the said east R/W line; THENCE N 00°51'16"E~329.02 feet and N 00°17'46"E~143.98 feet along said east R/W line TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma:

SECTION I. The subject tract is hereby annexed and added to the City of Clinton, Oklahoma.

SECTION II. The subject site shall be zoned A-1 Agricultural Zone District.

SECTION III. It is further ordained that owner(s) of said property may petition for deannexation and such petition shall be granted by the City Council at the next regular meeting.
