



**ORDINANCE NO. 776**

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING, ADDING AND ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF COLLINSVILLE, TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, ALL THAT CERTAIN REAL ESTATE BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREINAFTER; PROVIDING THAT SAID REAL ESTATE SHALL BE PART OF THE CITY OF COLLINSVILLE, OKLAHOMA, AND ALL PERSONS RESIDING THEREIN, IF ANY, AND ALL PROPERTY SITUATED THEREIN, SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE JURISDICTION, CONTROL, LAWS AND ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COLLINSVILLE, OKLAHOMA; DIRECTING NOTIFICATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Collinsville, Oklahoma, a municipal corporation, abuts, adjoins and is contiguous to unplatted property hereinafter described, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Collinsville, Oklahoma, desires to annex the property which is hereinafter described, and;

WHEREAS, the owner of the property to be annexed has consented to the annexation thereof, and;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Board of City Commissioners to annex said territory and to extend the boundaries of said City so as to include said property within its corporate limits.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF COLLINSVILLE, OKLAHOMA, THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** The following described land lying within the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, and which is adjacent to, abutting and contiguous to the present corporate limits of the City of Collinsville, a municipal corporation, be and the same, is hereby annexed and added to the City of Collinsville, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of the City of Collinsville are extended so as to include said property, to wit:

A tract of land situated in the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Twenty-two (22) North, Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

COMMENCING at Southwest Corner of said Southeast Quarter (SE/4); THENCE East along the South line of said Southeast Quarter (SE/4) a distance of 300.84 feet; THENCE N 11 degrees 41' 41" W a distance of 525.75 feet, THENCE Northerly on a curve to the right having a radius of 1859.85 feet for a distance of 264.17 feet to the Point of Beginning; THENCE continuing in a Northerly direction on a curve to the right, having a radius of 1859.68 feet for a distance of 74.25 feet; THENCE N 01 degrees 16' 09" W a distance of 325.76 feet; THENCE S 88 degrees 43' 51" W a distance of 60.01 feet to a point intersecting the new Right of Way line for Highway 169; THENCE in a Northerly direction along said new right of way line on a curve to the right, having a radius of 5559.58 feet for a distance of 169.92 feet. The chord bearing for this line is N 15 degrees 56' 15" E for a chord distance of 169.90 feet; THENCE N

89 degrees 20' 00" E a distance of 1162.81 feet; THENCE S 01 degrees 16' 09" E a distance of 550.07 feet; THENCE S 88 degrees 43' 51" W a distance of 1151.51 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING, 14.878 ACRES M/L.

**SECTION 2:** The City Clerk of the City of Collinsville, Oklahoma, is hereby directed to file a copy of the Ordinance, together with a plat or map or survey defining boundaries of the above described annexed territory, with the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

**SECTION 3:** That from and after the date of publication hereof, the effective date of this Ordinance, the above described real estate shall be part of the City of Collinsville, Oklahoma, in **Ward I** thereof, and bearing a zoning classification of **AG Agriculture**, and all persons residing therein, and all property situated therein and thereon, shall be and are hereby declared to be subject to the jurisdiction, control, laws and ordinances of the City of Collinsville, Oklahoma, in all respects and particulars.


PASSED, and the **EMERGENCY CLAUSE** ruled upon separately AND APPROVED this 20 Day of March 2006.




