

ORDINANCE NO. 518

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS TRACT OF LAND FORMING A PART OF SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGE 16 EAST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN IN WAGONER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; PROVIDING FOR ZONING CLASSIFICATION; MAKING ALL OF SAID TERRITORY A PART OF WARD 3 OF THE CITY OF COWETA, OKLAHOMA; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COWETA;

Section 1. That the following described tract of land lying contiguous to the present corporate limits of the City of Coweta, to wit:

The E/2 of the NW/4 of Section 20, Township 17 North, Range 16 east of the Indian Meridian, Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Coweta, Oklahoma finds the above described tract of land is adjacent to or contiguous to property already within the municipal limits of said City of Coweta.

Section 3. That Ordinance 377 be amended and that the AG (agriculture) zoning designation of the above described property is changed to the RS-1 (residential single family) designation by this annexation (CZ 98-05).

Section 4. That the above described property shall be part of Ward 3 of the City of Coweta.

Section 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 6. That if any parts hereof be held invalid or ineffective, the remaining portions shall not be affected but remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore that this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval



PASSED AND APPROVED with the emergency clause voted on separately this 2nd day of November, 1998.
