

ORDINANCE NO. 544

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LOT 16 OF BLOCK 3 OF THE SKYVIEW ADDITION, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF COWETA, WAGONER COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, INTO THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COWETA, GRANTING A ZONING CLASSIFICATION, ADOPTING A SERVICE PLAN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.



WHEREAS, Larry and Joyce Terry have requested annexation into the city limits of the City of Coweta;

WHEREAS, the above described property adjoins and is contiguous to the current city limits of the City of Coweta;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COWETA:

Section 1: That the following described tract of land lying adjacent to the present corporate limits of the City of Coweta, to wit:

Lot 16, Block 3, of the Skyview Addition, an Addition to the City of Coweta, Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma.

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Coweta, Oklahoma, and the corporate limits of said City are hereby extended to include the above described tract of land. After the effective date of this ordinance, all property located therein, and all persons residing or otherwise occupying the land shall be subject to the jurisdiction of this city and all laws made pursuant thereto. The land shall be assigned a zoning classification of AG and shall be in ward 4. The City Council expressly finds that all requirements of 11 Okla.Stat. Section 21-103 have been fully complied with in advance of the issuance of this ordinance.

Section 2: Police, fire, refuse and zoning services shall be extended immediately upon annexation.

Section 3: An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.




