

ORDINANCE 601

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS TRACT OF LAND IN WAGONER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; PROVIDING FOR ZONING CLASSIFICATION; MAKING ALL OF SAID TERRITORY A PART OF WARD 4 OF THE CITY OF COWETA, OKLAHOMA; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COWETA

Section 1. That the following described tract of land lying contiguous to the present corporate limits of the City of Coweta, to wit:

The North 20 feet of Sections 19,20,21,22,23,24, Township 18 North, Range 16 East.

The North 20 feet of Section 24, Township 18 North, Range 15 East

The West 20 feet of Section 24, Township 18 North, Range 15 East

The North 20 feet of Sections 26,27,28,29, Township 18 North, Range 15 East

The West 20 feet of Section 29, Township 18 North, Range 15 East

The West 20 feet of Section 31, Township 18 North, Range 15 East to a point where the Broken Arrow City Limits begin in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 31; thence due West following the Broken Arrow City Limits with a 20 foot wide strip of land to the Creek Turnpike South Loop right of way, thence South and West with a 20 foot strip of land paralleling the Creek Turnpike South Loop right of way and the Broken Arrow City Limits; thence due South paralleling the Broken Arrow City Limits with a 20 foot wide strip of land to the North line of the Rolling Acres Subdivision; thence due West with a 20 foot wide strip of land following the Broken Arrow City Limits to 193rd E Ave right of way; thence due South with a 20 foot wide strip of land to the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 31, Township 18 North, Range 15 East.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Coweta, Oklahoma finds the above described tract of land adjacent to or contiguous to property already within the municipal limits of said City of Coweta.



Section 3. That the above described property be zoned to the City of Coweta AG (Agricultural) classification.

Section 4. That the above described property shall be part of Ward 4 of the City of Coweta.

Section 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 6. That if any parts hereof be held invalid or ineffective, the remaining portions shall not be affected but remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore that this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.

PASSED AND APPROVED with the emergency clause voted upon separately this 2nd day of June, 2003.
