

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DUNCAN, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 1381 OF THE CITY OF DUNCAN TO REMOVE AND DE-ANNEX A TRACT OF LAND WITHIN SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 8 WEST, STEPHENS COUNTY ADJACENT TO THE CITY LIMITS OF SAID CITY AND DECLARE AND EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Duncan has determined that the annexation or the incorporation effected within Ordinance 1381 should be amended in accordance with a request by property owner Rick Braught; and

WHEREAS, the Duncan Municipal Planning Commission has considered this request and voted to recommend approval of this request to City Council; and

WHEREAS, property owner Rick Braught has requested to replace the de-annexed tract of land with a request for annexation of a different tract of land to replace the de-annexed tract of land; and

WHEREAS, Title 11 O.S., Section 21-110 et. seq., is the enabling legislation allowing said de-annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUNCAN, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance Number 1381, passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Duncan, Oklahoma, on October 10, 1995 be amended to remove and de-annex the following described tract of land.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

The east 202 feet of the west 235 feet of the NW/4 and the south 202 feet of the NW/4 less the west 235 feet of Section 33, Township 1 North, Range 8 West.

SECTION 2: WHEREAS, it being immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Duncan, Oklahoma, and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this ordinance be put in full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage as provided by law.


