



ORDINANCE 06-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, OKLAHOMA, ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY BY WRITTEN CONSENT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY'S ANNEXATION POLICY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the following property or tract involves written consent for purposes of annexation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best long-term interest of said City to annex said tract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Elgin, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. Elgin Corporate Limits Extended by Annexation. In accordance with the Annexation Policy of the City of Elgin, Oklahoma, the following tract is hereby annexed into said City. Total acreage is 25 acres, more or less.

Beginning at a point 100 feet North of the Southeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4), Section Twenty-five (25), Township Four North (4N), Range Eleven West (11W), of I.M., Comanche County, Oklahoma, according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof; Thence North along the East line of said Southeast Quarter a distance of 2073.3 feet to the South East Right of Way line of H.E. Bailey Turnpike; Thence Southwesterly on a curve to the left having a radius of 11,284.2 feet a distance of 746.2 feet; Thence S30°08'W a distance of 610.7 feet; Thence S13°06'W a distance of 235.3 feet; Thence S02°51'W a distance of 386.2 feet; Thence South a distance of 197.3 feet; Thence S45°00'E a distance of 164.1 feet; Thence East a distance of 658.8 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. Conflicting Ordinances Repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the general public of the City of Elgin, Oklahoma, and in order to immediately extend its corporate limits, an emergency is hereby declared; therefore, this ordinance shall become effective from and after its date of publication.
