

ORDINANCE 08-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, OKLAHOMA,
DETACHING CERTAIN PROPERTY BY PETITION, IN ACCORDANCE
WITH OKLAHOMA STATUTE 11-21-110; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by at least three-fourths of the registered voters and by the owners of at least three fourths, in value, of the property to be detached, was filed with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, a public notice was published in local newspaper and a public hearing conducted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Elgin, Oklahoma:


SECTION 1. Elgin Corporate Limits Reduced by Detachment. In accordance with Oklahoma Statute 11-21-110, the following tract is hereby detached from the Elgin Corporate Limits.

A tract of land described as beginning at a point 1333 feet East of the Southwest corner of the South line of Lots One(1) and Two (2) and the East half of the Northwest quarter (E ½ NW ¼) Section Nineteen (19), Township Four North (T-4-N), Range Ten West (R-10-W), Comanche County, Oklahoma and 720 feet North along the East line of Hillcrest Park Addition, Comanche County, Oklahoma, thence East 933.5 feet on a line running parallel to said South line, thence North 820 feet on the East line of said Northwest quarter (NW ¼), thence West 820 feet running parallel to the South line of said NW ¼, thence South 840 feet to the Northeast corner of Hillcrest Park Addition, thence South 180 feet on the East line of Hillcrest Park Addition to the point of beginning, containing 17.45 acres more or less, and as recorded with the County Clerk of Comanche County, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. Conflicting Ordinances Repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the general public of the City of Elgin, Oklahoma, and in order to immediately extend its corporate limits, an emergency is hereby declared; therefore, this ordinance shall become effective from and after its date of publication.
