

ORDINANCE NO 1058

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELK CITY, OKLAHOMA ANNEXING PROPERTY IN SECTION TWENTY SIX, TOWNSHIP ELEVEN, NORTH RANGE TWENTY ONE, WIM, CITY OF ELK CITY, BECKHAM COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; CLASSIFYING THE ZONING THEREOF; CLASSIFYING THE WARD THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

AND WHEREAS, it is the best interests of the citizens of Elk City, Oklahoma, that orderly annexation of property adjacent or contiguous to the city limits be carried out;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ELK CITY, OKLAHOMA:

1. That the following described property should be and the same is hereby annexed to and incorporated within the corporate city limits of Elk City, Oklahoma and assigned the corresponding zoning and ward classification set forth below:


A Tract of land lying in the East Half of Section 26, Township 11 North, Range 21 West of the Indian Meridan, described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 26; thence North 2390.7 feet to a point on the Easterly right-of-way line of Interstate Highway No. I-40; thence North 40°08' East and along said highway right-of-way 1032.5 feet to the intersection of said Easterly right-of-way line of Interstate Highway No. I-40 and the Westerly right-of-way of the C.R.I. & P. Railroad; thence Southwesterly on a curve to the left having a radius of 1959.9 feet and along said railroad right-of-way line 405.0 feet; thence South 2957.2 feet; thence West 1022.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing 67.1 acres, more or less, less and except all of the oil, gas and other minerals.

Zoning: I-1, Light Industrial District
Ward: #1


2. It being necessary for the protection of the public peace and the health and safety of the citizens of Elk City, Oklahoma, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the City Commission.

If any provision or clause of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or clauses of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or clause, and to this end the provisions and clauses of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.




