

ORDINANCE NO 1086

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELK CITY, OKLAHOMA ANNEXING A TRACT OF LAND LOCATED IN THE NE QUARTER OF SECTION 19, T11 N, R 21 WIM, BECKHAM COUNTY, FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE NORTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 19, A DISTANCE OF 303.0 FEET, N89°09'51"W OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19; THENCE S01°14'12"W PARALLEL TO THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 19, A DISTANCE OF 1143.00 FEET; THENCE N89°09'51"W, 20.00 FT; THENCE N43°57'50" W, 28.19 FEET; THENCE N89°09'51"W, 310.00 FT; THENCE N01°14'12" E, 180.00 FT; THENCE N89°09'51" W, 60.00 FT; THENCE N01°14'12"E, 943.00 FT, TO A POINT ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 19; THENCE S89°09'51"E, 410.00 FT TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 10.34 ACRES ;CLASSIFYING THE ZONING THEREOF; CLASSIFYING THE WARD THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

AND WHEREAS, it is the best interests of the citizens of Elk City, Oklahoma, that orderly annexation of property adjacent or contiguous to the city limits be carried out;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ELK CITY, OKLAHOMA:

1. That the following described property should be and the same is hereby annexed to and incorporated within the corporate city limits of Elk City, Oklahoma and assigned the corresponding zoning and ward classification set forth below:

A tract of land located in the NE Quarter of Section 19, Township 11 North, Range 21 WIM, Beckham County, further described as follows: Beginning at a point on the North line of said Section 19, a distance of 303.0 feet, N89°09'51"W of the Northeast corner of Section 19; thence S01°14'12"W parallel to the East line of Section 19, a distance of 1143.00 feet; thence N89°09'51"W, 20.00 ft; thence N43°57'50" W, 28.19 feet; thence N89°09'51"W, 310.00 ft; thence N01°14'12" E, 180.00 ft; thence N89°09'51" W, 60.00 ft; thence N01°14'12"E, 943.00 ft; to a point on the North line of Section 19; thence S89°09'51"E, 410.00 ft to the point of beginning, containing 10.34 acres

Zoning: R-1, Single Family Residential District
Ward: #2

2. It being necessary for the protection of the public peace and the health and safety of the citizens of Elk City, Oklahoma, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the City Commission.

3. If any provision or clause of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or clauses of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or clause, and to this end the provisions and clauses of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.
