AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ENID, OKLAHOMA, BY ACTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ENID, PURSUANT TO THE CONSENT OF THE OWNERS OF A MAJORITY OF THE ACRES TO BE ANNEXED; DESIGNATING THE AREAS OR TRACTS INCLUDED IN SUCH EXTENSION; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORITY FOR SUCH EXTENSION AND ANNEXATION; SAVINGS CLAUSE; SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.



EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ENID, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION I. PROPERTY ANNEXED BY ACTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY.

That the corporate limits of the City of Enid, Oklahoma, shall be and the same are hereby extended to include and thereby annex certain tracts of land situated in Garfield County, Oklahoma, as further described by Exhibit "A", and shown by the map by Exhibit "B", both exhibits being attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if fully set out.

SECTION II. AUTHORITY. The Mayor and Board of Commissioners find that it has received in writing the consent of the owners of at least a majority of the acres to be annexed, which written consent is on file in the office of the City Clerk. This annexation by the governing body with consent of the owners is authorized by 11 O.S. §21-101 and 103.

Section III. SAVINGS CLAUSE. Nothing in this ordinance hereby adopted, shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding now pending in any court, or any rights acquired or liability incurred, nor any cause or causes of action accrued or existing, under any act or ordinance repealed hereby. No right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

Section IV. SEVERABILITY. The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.


Section V. DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and public good of the City of Enid, and the inhabitants thereof and the immediate annexation of 19.150 acres west of Vance Air Force Base into the corporate limits of the City of Enid; therefore an emergency is hereby declared whereby the provisions of this ordinance shall be put into full force and effect after its passage, as provided by law.



**LEGAL DESCRIPTION**

A tract of land within the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Twenty-two (22) North, Range Seven (7) West of the Indian Meridian, Garfield County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Twenty-two (22) North, Range Seven (7) West of the Indian Meridian; thence West 490 feet to the point of beginning; thence South 290 feet; thence Southwesterly on a straight line to a point being 440 feet South and 540 feet West of the Northeast corner of said Southwest Quarter; thence West 1,099 feet; thence North 200 feet; thence West 540 feet; thence South 200 feet; thence West 470 feet; thence North 440 feet to the Northwest Corner of the said Southwest Quarter; thence 2,150 feet East to the point of beginning, containing 19.150 acres more or less.
