



ORDINANCE NO. 493

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AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY INTO THE CITY OF GLENPOOL, OKLAHOMA, MUNICIPAL LIMITS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the owner of certain real property has requested of the City of Glenpool, Oklahoma, that such real property be annexed into the City of Glenpool, Oklahoma; and,

WHEREAS, the request for annexation has been published twice in the Glenpool Post as required by law; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered and determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Glenpool, Oklahoma, to accept and act upon the petitioners' request for incorporation into the municipal limits,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT SHALL BE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the following described real estate be and the same is hereby annexed into the City of Glenpool:

SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER (SE/4, NW/4) LESS AND EXCEPT THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER (NE/4, SE/4, NW/4) ALL IN SECTION 12- TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH - RANGE 12 EAST - OF THE INDIAN BASE AND MERIDIAN, TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, CONTAINING 30 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

- 2. That said property shall be zoned AG Agricultural, and,
- 3. That such annexation is pursuant to the City Ordinances of the City of Glenpool, Oklahoma, and further pursuant to State Statutes of the State of Oklahoma.
