



ORDINANCE # 3231

ORDINANCE DEANNEXING A PORTION OF FORREST HILLS ROAD AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF
GUTHRIE, OKLAHOMA AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That Forrest Hills Road from Oakwood Drive west to Bryant Road lying within the southeast quarter of Section 12, T15N, R3W and the northeast quarter of Section 13, T15N, R3W; and the southwest quarter of Section 7, T15N, R2W; and the northwest quarter of Section 18, T15N, R2W to the IM all in Logan County, Oklahoma is deannexed from the city limits of the City of Guthrie, Logan County, Oklahoma. Only Forest Hills Road, the public right of way, is affected by this ordinance and deannexed by this ordinance.

Section 2. Severability. If any part, article, section or subsection of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to invalidate the remainder of this ordinance, notwithstanding such holding.

Section 3. Repealer. Any ordinance in conflict herewith is repealed.

Section 4. EMERGENCY. It being immediately necessary for protection of the public health, safety and welfare of the Citizens of the Guthrie, Oklahoma an emergency is declared and the ordinance will go into effect immediately upon passage by the City Council.

The foregoing ordinance is introduced before the City Council of the City of Guthrie, Oklahoma, on the 1st day of May, 2012 and was duly adopted and approved by the Mayor and City Council on said date and the EMERGENCY was approved.
