

ORDINANCE NO. 942

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF HENRYETTA, OKLAHOMA, CERTAIN TERRITORY ADJACENT TO SAID CITY, AND INCREASING, EXTENDING AND ESTABLISHING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HENRYETTA, OKLAHOMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.



WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, that it is desirable at this time to extend the limits of said City, by annexing the herein after described tract and parcel of land to the City of Henryetta, Okmulgee County, State of Oklahoma, as the same is now constituted; and

WHEREAS, all the owners of the property have consented to the annexation in writing and the property is adjacent to the current city limits,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENRYETTA:

SECTION 1. That the following territory is adjacent or contiguous to the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, as the same is now constituted, be and the same is, hereby annexed to and made a part of the City of Henryetta, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northwest Corner of the East Half of the North Half of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$); thence South 200 feet; thence East 240 feet; thence North 200 feet; thence West 240 feet to the point of beginning all located in Section 27, Township 11 North, Range 12 East, Okmulgee County, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. That the present boundaries and limits of the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, as they are now constituted, be, and the same are, hereby extended, so as to include and embrace within the limits of said City of Henryetta, State of Oklahoma, all of the above described land.

SECTION 3. That, because of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and by reason of which this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

PASSED and APPROVED this 17th day of December, 2002; the emergency clause being resolved upon separately, and likewise approved this 17th day of December, 2002.
