

ORDINANCE NO. 943

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF HENRYETTA, OKLAHOMA, CERTAIN TERRITORY ADJACENT TO SAID CITY, AND INCREASING, EXTENDING AND ESTABLISHING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HENRYETTA, OKLAHOMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, that it is desirable at this time to extend the limits of said City, by annexing the herein after described tract and parcel of land to the City of Henryetta, Okmulgee County, State of Oklahoma, as the same is now constituted; and

WHEREAS, all the owners of the property have consented to the annexation in writing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENRYETTA:


SECTION 1. That the following territory is adjacent or contiguous to the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, as the same is now constituted, be and the same is, hereby annexed to and made a part of the City of Henryetta, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

U.S. 75 Highway right of way from A street as the North boundary to a point 10 feet North of the North entrance and exit ramps to Interstate 40 Highway (A map showing the annexed area is attached)


SECTION 2. That the present boundaries and limits of the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, as they are now constituted, be, and the same are, hereby extended, so as to include and embrace within the limits of said City of Henryetta, State of Oklahoma, all of the above described land.

SECTION 3. That, because of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and by reason of which this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

PASSED and APPROVED this 17th day of December, 2002; the emergency clause being resolved upon separately, and likewise approved this 17th day of December, 2002.
