

ORDINANCE NO. 951

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF HENRYETTA, OKLAHOMA, CERTAIN TERRITORY ADJACENT TO SAID CITY, AND INCREASING, EXTENDING AND ESTABLISHING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HENRYETTA, OKLAHOMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma that it is desirable at this time to extend the limits of said City, by annexing the herein after described tract and parcel of land to the City of Henryetta, Okmulgee County, State of Oklahoma, as the same is now constituted; and

WHEREAS, all the owners of the property have consented to the annexation in writing and the property is adjacent to the current city limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENRYETTA:

SECTION 1. That the following territory is adjacent or contiguous to the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, as the same is now constituted, be and the same is, hereby annexed to and made a part of the City of Henryetta, Okmulgee County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All that part of Lot 3, (Lot 3 being the NW ¼ of SW ¼) of Section 30, Township 11 North, Range 13 East of the Indian Meridian, described as follows: Beginnings at a point 20 feet South of the Northwest Corner of Lot 3; thence South 678 ½ feet thence East about 485 feet to the West Right of Way line of the Highway; thence Northwesterly along the West Right of Way line of said Highway to a point about 20 feet South of the North line of Lot 3; thence West 145 to the point of beginning.


SECTION 2. That the present boundaries and limits of the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, as they are now constituted, be, and the same are hereby extended, so as to include and embrace within the limits of said City of Henryetta, State of Oklahoma, all of the above described land.

SECTION 3. That, because of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Henryetta, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and by reason of which this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
