ORDINANCE NO. 2000-4

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF ADDITIONAL TERRITORY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF HINTON, OKLAHOMA; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY THE Town Council of the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma, that more than two weeks prior to this date a petition, in writing, signed by the legal owner (s) of the hereinafter described real estate was presented to the town council requesting annexation of said described property and that notice of said petition has been given by publication in the July 12th, 2000, and the July 19th, 2000, of the Hinton Record, which newspaper is published in the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma, all as required by the laws of the State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, an accurate map of said territory proposed to be annexed by said petition has been presented to the Town Council of the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by said Town Council that all of the necessary steps have been taken and all of the relevant Statutes of the State of Oklahoma and the of ordinances of the Town of Hinton relating to such annexation procedures have been complied within their entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HINTON, OKLAHOMA:


Section 1. That the following described territory is hereby annexed to the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma: Commencing at a #4 iron rod found for the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of said Section Twenty-seven (27); thence North 90°00'00" West along the South line of said section, a distance of 668.60 feet to a PK nail found for the centerline of said N-S road and utility easement; thence North 00°00'00" East, a distance of 533.00 feet to a #3 iron rod w/cap set, the Point-of-Beginning; thence North 90°00'00" West, a distance of 249.55 feet to a #3 iron rod w/cap set; thence North 31°55'07" East, a distance of 80.78 feet to a #3 iron rod w/cap set; thence North 56°32'00" West, a distance of 90.00 feet to a #3 iron rod w/cap set; thence North 33°28'00" East, a distance of 924.20 feet along the East side easement boundary line of US Highway 281; thence Northeasterly along a curve to the left on said easement boundary line having a radius of 2914.9 feet, a distance of 177.35 feet to a #3 iron rod w/cap set; thence South 56°32'00" East, a distance of 10.00 feet to a #3 iron rod w/cap set; thence Northeasterly along a curve to the left on said East easement



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boundary line having a radius of 2924.90 feet, a distance of 288.02 feet to a #3 iron rod w/cap set; thence South 89°48'29" East a distance of 169.23 feet to a #3 iron rod w/cap set; thence South 00°28'22" East along the East line of said Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Twenty-seven (27), a distance of 379.55 feet to a #3 iron rod w/cap set; thence South 34°44'01" West, a distance of 1109.48 feet to a #3 iron rod w/cap set; thence North 90°00'00" West, a distance of 25.00 feet to the Point-of-Beginning, containing 436,653 square feet or 10.00 acres, more or less.



