ORDINANCE NO. 2000-6

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF
ADDITIONAL TERRITORY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED TO THE
CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF HINTON, OKLAHOMA;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY THE Town Council of the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma, that more than two weeks prior to this date a petition, in writing, signed by the legal owner (s) of the hereinafter described real estate was presented to the town council requesting annexation of said described property and that notice of said petition has been given by publication in the November 29th, 2000, and the December 6th, 2000, of the Hinton Record, which newspaper is published in the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma, all as required by the laws of the State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, an accurate map of said territory proposed to be annexed by said petition has been presented to the Town Council of the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by said Town Council that all of the necessary steps have been taken and all of the relevant Statutes of the State of Oklahoma and the of ordinances of the Town of Hinton relating to such annexation procedures have been complied within their entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HINTON, OKLAHOMA:


Section 1. That the following described territory is hereby annexed to the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma:



A tract of land in the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section Ten (10), Township Twelve (12) North, Range Eleven (11) West, I.M., described as beginning at a point 1320 feet East and 50 feet South of the Northwest corner of the said Northeast Quarter (NE ¼) of Section Ten (10); and on the South Right-of- Way line of U.S. Highway #66; thence East along said Right-of Way a distance of 251.40 feet; thence South a distance of 208.71 feet; thence West a distance of 251.40 feet; thence North 208.71 feet to the point of beginning.
