

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF HINTON, OKLAHOMA, PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF ADDITIONAL TERRITORY HEREINAFTER DESIGNATED TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID TOWN OF HINTON, OKLAHOMA; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma have determined that certain parcels of land which are surrounded by property which is within the Town's corporate limits have not previously been annexed into or otherwise made a part of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds it is in the best interest of the Town and its citizens to clarify and normalize the Town's boundaries and borders; and

WHEREAS, all of the parcels at issue are lots which are platted and recorded on the Town's maps and records and which have homes on them; and

WHEREAS, all of the owners of said parcels have agreed to annexation; and

WHEREAS, an accurate map of the territory annexed by hereby has been presented to and reviewed by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that all of the necessary steps have been taken and all of the relevant Statutes of the State of Oklahoma and Ordinances of the Town of Hinton relating to such annexation procedures have been complied with in their entirety;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HINTON, OKLAHOMA:


Section 1. That the following described territory is hereby annexed to the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma:


- A. T12N R11W of the I.M. S33 NE BEG 1985'N 33'W SE/C NE N1\*03' W100' N88\* 57' W140' S1\*03' E100' 88\*57' E140 to POB, Caddo County, Oklahoma, commonly described as **700 N. Marion**;
- B. T12N R11W of the I.M. S33 NE BEG 2085'N & 33'W of SE/C NE SEC N1\*33' W100' N88\* 37' W140' S1\*03' E100' S88\*57' E140' to POB, Caddo County, Oklahoma, commonly described as **702 N. Marion**;
- C. T12N R11W of the I.M. S33 NE BEG 2185'N & 33'W of SE/C NE SEC N1\*03' W100' S88\* 57' W140' S1\*03' to POB, Caddo County, Oklahoma, commonly described as **704 N. Marion**;
- D. T12N R11W of the I.M. S33 NE BEG 2285'N & 33'W SE/C NE N1\*03' W100' N88\* 57' W140' S1\*03' E100' S88\*57' E140 to POB, Caddo County, Oklahoma, commonly described as **706 N. Marion**;
- E. T12N R11 W of the I.M. S33 NE BEG 2385'N & 33'W SE/C NE N1\*03' W125' N88\* 57' W140' S1\*03' E125' S88\*57' E140, to POB, Caddo County, Oklahoma, commonly described as **710 N. Marion**.

Section 2. Emergency Clause. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the health, peace, and safety of the residents of the Town of Hinton, Oklahoma, and emergency is hereby declare to exist whereby this ordinance, shall be in full force an effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.
