AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY AND INCORPORATING THE SAME WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF HUGO, OKLAHOMA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 11 SECTION 21-103 OF THE OKLAHOMA STATUTES.

WHEREAS, the owner of real property of the territory described in this ordinance is the City of Hugo, Oklahoma; the City of Hugo on the 20th day of November, 2007 agreed and consented to the proposed annexation as required by 11 O.S. § 21-103

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed annexation of the territory described in this ordinance was published in the Hugo Daily News on the December 21, 2007, pursuant to the requirements of 11 O.S. § 21-103(B)(1).

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the Hugo City Council was held on the 8th day of January 2008, and notice of said hearing was published in the Hugo Daily News on the 21st day of December, 2007, pursuant to the requirements of 11 O.S. § 21-103(B)(1) and (3).

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hugo has consented to the property described below to be annexed to the City of Hugo.

WHEREAS, the Municipal purpose for the proposed annexation of the territory described in this ordinance is to protect and safeguard Hugo public parks and recreational area by providing police protection to insure the public health is not compromised by acts of vandalism or terrorism on Hugo's public parks and recreation areas.

NOW, therefore be it ordained by the City of Hugo, County of Choctaw, State of Oklahoma, that the following described lands, situated in Choctaw County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Tract 1

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in the SE/4 of Section 22, Township 6 South, Range 17 East, Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Starting at the NE Corner of said SE/4, thence running West along the 1/4 Section Line a distance of 745.2 feet for a place of beginning; thence continue West a distance of 320 feet; thence running Southwesterly a distance of 555 feet to a point on the North line of Lloyd Street, said point being 60 feet North and 30 feet East of the NE Corner of Block 11 in the Rena Kirkpatrick Addition; thence running East along the North line of Lloyd Street a distance of 30 feet; thence running South a distance of 400 feet to the SW Corner of Lot 4 in Block 11 in the Rena Kirkpatrick Addition; thence running East a distance of 360 feet to the East boundary line of Block 10 in the Rena Kirkpatrick Addition; thence running North along the East boundary of Block 10 in the Rena Kirkpatrick Addition a distance of 340 feet to the NW Corner of said Block 10; thence running East along the North boundary line of said Block 10 a distance of

154.8 feet; thence running North a distance of 560 feet to the place of beginning, containing 8.50 acres, more or less.

Tract 2

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in the SE/4 of Section 22, Township 6 South, Range 17 East, Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit; Beginning at the NE Corner of said SE/4, thence running South along the Section Line a distance of 300 feet; thence South 84°47' W 220 feet; thence S 3°28" W 180 feet; thence West 235.2 feet; thence South 60 feet to the NE corner of Lot No. 7 in Block 10, Rena Kirkpatrick Addition to the City of Hugo; thence West along the North Line of said Block 10 a distance of 180 feet; thence North a distance of 560 feet to a point on the North Line of said SE/4 of Section 22; thence East a distance of 745.2 feet to the place of beginning, 7.99 acres, more or less.


Tract 3

Are herewith annexed to, included within the limits and shall be a part of the City of Hugo, Oklahoma.


