

ORDINANCE # 823

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY AND INCORPORATING THE SAME WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF HUGO, OKLAHOMA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 11 SECTION 21-105 OF THE OKLAHOMA STATUTES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 O.S. § 21-105, more than three-fourths of the legal voters and the owners of at least three-fourths (in value) of certain real property contiguous and adjacent to the City of Hugo petitioned the City of Hugo to annex the following described real property located in the County of Choctaw, State of Oklahoma to-wit:

A piece or parcel of land lying in the SE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 6 South, Range 18 East of the I.B.& M, Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: BEGINNING 23.7 feet East of the NW Corner of the SE 1/4, thence S0°13' W a distance of 2112.3 feet, thence N 71°52'30" E a distance of 263 feet, thence N 0°13' E a distance of 1780.5 feet, thence East a distance of 224.1 feet to the Government Land Boundary, thence Northwesterly along the Government Land Boundary a distance of 300.4 feet, thence West a distance of 307.5 feet to the place of BEGINNING, containing 12.7 acres, more or less.

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed annexation of the territory described in this ordinance was published in the Hugo Daily News on October 15th, 2008 and October 20th, 2008, pursuant to the requirements of 11 O.S. § 21-103.

NOW, therefore be it ordained by the City of Hugo, County of Choctaw, State of Oklahoma, that the following described lands, situated in Choctaw County, Oklahoma, to-wit:



It being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Hugo, Oklahoma and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, to wit: in order to provide police protection to said territory. By reason whereof, it is


necessary that this Ordinance go into full effect and be of force immediately upon its passage and approval.







Choctaw County




*Kiamichi Village
