ORDINANCE # 852

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY AND INCORPORATING THE SAME WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF HUGO, OKLAHOMA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 11 SECTION 21-103 OF THE OKLAHOMA STATUTES AND ENACTING AN EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, the owners of real property of the territory described in this ordinance were notified of the proposed annexation as required by 11 O.S. § 21-103(B)(2).

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed annexation of the territory described in this ordinance was published in the Hugo Daily News on the 9th day of February, 2011, pursuant to the requirements of 11 O.S. § 21-103(B)(1).

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the Hugo City Council was held on the 24th day of February 2011, and notice of said hearing was published in the Hugo Daily News on the 9th day of February, 2011, pursuant to the requirements of 11 O.S. § 21-103(B)(1) and (3).


WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 O.S. § 21-103(A)(2), no such consent of the property owners of the territory to be annexed is required because three sides of the territory to be annexed are adjacent or contiguous to the property already within the municipal limits and the adjacent property on each side constitutes an area in width greater than three hundred (300) feet at its narrowest point excluding a roadway or right-of-way that is adjacent or contiguous to the territory, however said owners have consented to annexation.

WHEREAS, the Municipal purpose for the proposed annexation of the territory described in this ordinance is to delineate with certainty the boundaries of the city limits of the City of Hugo, Oklahoma in order to provide law enforcement and fire protective services precise boundaries of their jurisdiction, as well as delineate with certainty the boundaries for City wards for purposes of voting in municipal elections and municipal questions.

The Plan to implement all City of Hugo municipal services to the territory to be annexed shall include, but is not limited to, water, sewer, fire protection, and law enforcement. Said services are already provided to the territory to be annexed.

NOW, therefore be it ordained by the City of Hugo, County of Choctaw, State of Oklahoma, that the following described lands, situated in Choctaw County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

A strip, piece or parcel of land located in NW/4 NW/4 NE/4 of Section 26, Township 6 South, Range 17 East, Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Southeast corner of said NW/4 NW/4 NE/4, thence running North a distance of 264 feet; thence running West a distance of 330 feet, thence running South a distance of 264 feet, thence running East a distance of 330 feet to the place of beginning containing 2 acres, more or less,



And

A strip, piece or parcel of land located in the NW/4 NW/4 NE/4 of Section 26, Township 6 South, Range 17 East, Choctaw County, Oklahoma, more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point 264 feet North of the SE corner of NW/4 NW/4 NE/4 of Section 26, Township 6 South, Range 17 East for place of beginning, thence running North a distance of 264 feet, thence running West a distance of 330 feet, thence running South a distance of 264 feet, thence running East a distance of 330 feet to the place of beginning containing 2 acres, more or less,

And

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in the NW/4 NW/4 NE/4 of Section 26, Township 6 South, Range 17 East, Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Starting at the SE corner of said NW/4 NW/4 NE/4, thence running North a distance of 528 feet for a place of beginning, thence continue North a distance of 132 feet to a point on the Section line, thence running West 330 feet, thence running South a distance of 132 feet, thence running East a distance of 330 feet to the place of beginning, and beginning at the Southwest corner of said NW/4 NW/4 NE/4, thence running North a distance of 132 feet, thence running East a distance of 330 feet: thence running South a distance of 132 feet, thence running West a distance of 330 feet to the place of beginning, and beginning at a point on the North boundary line of said SW/4 NW/4 NE/4 a distance of 388.1 feet West of its Northeast corner, thence running West a distance of 119 feet 3 inches to a point on the Northerly right of way of U.S. Highway 70; thence running South 51 degrees 4 minutes East 155 feet 3 inches along said right of way line, thence running North a distance of 99.5 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.13 acres, more or less, making a total of 2.13 acres,

And

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in the NW/4 NW/4 NE/4 of Section 26, Township 6 South, Range 17 East, Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the NW corner of said NW/4 NW/4 NE/4, thence running South a distance of 264 feet, thence running East a distance of 330 feet, thence running North 264 feet, thence running West 330 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2 acres, more or less,

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in the NW/4 NW/4 NE/4 of Section 26, Township 6 South, Range 17 East, Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Starting at the Southwest corner of said NW/4 NW/4 NE/4, thence running North a distance of 132 feet for a place of beginning; thence continue North a distance of 132 feet, thence running East a distance of 330 feet, thence running South a distance of 132 feet, thence running West a distance of 330 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1 acre, more or less,

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in the NW/4 NW/4 NE/4 of Section 26, Township 6 South, Range 17 East, Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Starting at the Southwest corner of said NW/4 NW/4 NE/4, thence running North a distance of 264 feet for a place of beginning, thence continue North a distance of 132 feet, thence running East a distance of 330 feet, thence running South a distance of 132 feet, thence running West a distance of 330 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1 acre, more or less

Are herewith annexed to, included within the limits and shall be a part of the City of Hugo, Oklahoma.

IT BEING NECESSARY for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Hugo, Oklahoma and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is thereby declared to exist. By reason of whereof it is necessary that this Ordinance will go into full effect and be of force immediately upon its passage and approval.






Hugo, Oklahoma Choctaw County
