

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY ADJACENT TO THE TOWN LIMITS UPON PETITION OF THE OWNER, SAID TERRITORY BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

All that part of the NW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 26, Township 17 North, Range 20 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Cherokee County; lying south and east of the center line of State Highway No. 80, containing 27.76 acres more or less,

LESS AND EXCEPT, the South 75.00 feet of the West 95.00 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 26, Township 17 North, Range 20 East.

WHEREAS, the owners of at least a majority of the acres described in Section 1 of this ordinance, said land being contiguous to and adjacent to the Town of Hulbert, have requested in writing that the same be annexed to and added to the Town;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HULBERT, OKLAHOMA, THAT:

Section 1: The area by which the petition seeks annexation is described as follows:  
All that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 26, Township 17 North, Range 20 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Cherokee County; lying south and east of the center line of State Highway No. 80, containing 27.76 acres more or less.

LESS AND EXCEPT, the South 75.00 feet of the West 95.00 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 26, Township 17 North, Range 20 East.

Section 2: The increase of the Town by the annexation of the hereinbefore described property will redound to the benefit of the Town and the same is hereby annexed.


Section 3: A copy of the Ordinance, together with an accurate map of the territory annexed, certified by the Mayor and the City Clerk, shall be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Cherokee County, Oklahoma.

Section 4: SEVERABILITY, Should any section, subsection, sentence, provision, clause, or phrase hereof be held invalid, void, or unconstitutional for any reason, such holding shall not render invalid, void, or unconstitutional any other section, subsection, sentence, provision, clause, or phrase of this ordinance, and the same are deemed severable for this purpose.

Section 5: EMERGENCY, This Ordinance being designated to protect the health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Hulbert, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist whereby the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication.


