

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL IN AND FOR THE CITY OF IDABEL, OKLAHOMA, EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF IDABEL, OKLAHOMA, AND DESIGNATING THE WARD WHICH SAID PROPERTY SHALL BECOME A PART OF.

WHEREAS, the City of Idabel, Oklahoma, desires to extend the corporate limits of the City of Idabel, Oklahoma, in accordance with the Comprehensive Plan adopted by the City.

WHEREAS, written consent of the owners of at least a majority of the acres to be annexed to the City of Idabel, Oklahoma has been obtained.

WHEREAS, a final "Municipal Services Plan" has been prepared and is attached hereto and incorporated into this ordinance;

WHEREAS, the property annexed to the City of Idabel, Oklahoma shall be designated to Ward 2 in the City of Idabel, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, that for the health and safety of the City of Idabel, it is necessary that this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council in and for the City of Idabel, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1: That the corporate limits of the City of Idabel, Oklahoma, be and they are hereby extended so as to include the following property located and situated in McCurtain County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

TRACT NO. 1: A strip of parcel of land 300 ft. in width and being in part of Section 26, Township 7 South, Range 24 East. Said tract being described as the West 300 ft. of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 lying adjacent to U.S. Highway 259 in said Section 26, Township 7 South, Range 24 East.

PASSED and the EMERGENCY CLAUSE ruled upon separately by the Council of the City of Idabel, Oklahoma, and signed by the Mayor of said City this 5th day of September, 2000.
