ORDINANCE NO. 566

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL IN AND FOR THE CITY OF IDABEL, OKLAHOMA, EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF IDABEL, OKLAHOMA, AND DESIGNATING THE WARD WHICH SAID PROPERTY SHALL BECOME A PART OF.

WHEREAS, the City of Idabel, Oklahoma, desires to extend the corporate limits of the City of Idabel, Oklahoma, in accordance with the Comprehensive Plan adopted by the City.

WHEREAS, written consent of the owner of the acres to be annexed to the City of Idabel, Oklahoma has been obtained.

WHEREAS, a final "Municipal Services Plan" has been prepared and is attached hereto and incorporated into this ordinance;

WHEREAS, all property annexed to the City of Idabel, Oklahoma, shall be designated as Ward 2.

WHEREAS, that for the immediate execution and performance of contracts for the extension of sewer and water utilities, health and safety of the City of Idabel, it is necessary that this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council in and for the City of Idabel, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1: That the corporate limits of the City of Idabel, Oklahoma, be and they are hereby extended so as to include the following property located and situated in McCurtain County, Oklahoma, to-wit:


A 2 ft. strip of land beginning on the present East city limit line and being the North 2 feet of the present R/W of S.H. 3; Run thence East to a point 80 feet East of the SW corner of the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36, Township 7 South, Range 24 East; Thence North 208.8 feet; thence East 208.8 feet; thence South 208.8 feet; thence West 208.8 feet to the point of beginning; Containing 1 acre more or less. And said 2 ft. strip containing .5 acre for a total of 1.5 acres more or less. (Kiamichi Youth Services)
