AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY INTO CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF INOLA, OKLAHOMA, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a municipal governing body by ordinance may add to the municipality territory adjacent or contiguous to its corporate limits and increase or diminish the corporate limits as the governing body deems desirable for the benefit of the municipality;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Inola, Oklahoma (the "Board"), proposes to annex certain territory into the corporate limits of the Town of Inola, Oklahoma (the "Town"), pursuant to the specific provisions of Title 11 O.S. §§ 21-101 and 21-104, and for the reasons set forth herein;

WHEREAS, the Town Board has held a public hearing and took public comment regarding the annexation of the property annexed herein;

WHEREAS, the proposed territory is adjacent and contiguous to the Town, receives the same services as all other similar areas of the Town, and will continue to receive such services by the same methods and/or means;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that all the requisites to annexing the territory have been satisfied and met, all as required by law;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined it to be in the best interest of the Town to annex the aforementioned territory;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF INOLA, OKLAHOMA:**

Section 1: That, pursuant to the laws made and provided by the State of Oklahoma the real property hereinafter described may be lawfully annexed to the Town and, henceforth for all purposes, considered a part of the Town.

Section 2: That the following described real property and premises, situated in Rogers County, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby annexed to the Town of Inola, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  less and except that part described lying South of the fence line in Book 861 at Page 536, all in Section 33, Township 20 North, Range 17 East of the I. B. & M., Rogers County, Oklahoma, according to the U.S. Government survey thereof.

Section 3: That there shall be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Rogers County, Oklahoma, a true and certified copy of this Ordinance.

Section 4: If any section, subsection or sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision or decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 5: The Plan to Extend Services to the Territory Proposed for Annexation previously adopted by the Town Board and on file with the Town Clerk is hereby adopted as the Final Plan and is set forth in Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference.

Section 6. For the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and by reason whereof this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Passed and the emergency clause ruled upon separately and approved in regular session this 23rd day of February, 2004.


