

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-1

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY TO THE TOWN OF KINGSTON, OKLAHOMA



BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Kingston, Oklahoma, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Town of Kingston, Oklahoma, having received the written consent of resident owners of more than a majority of acres to be annexed and incorporated into the territorial limits of the Town, said property being adjacent or contiguous to the Town, hereby annexes said property, described as follows:

The S/2 of S/2 of Section 28, the S/2 of S/2 of Section 27, the S/2 of S/2 of Section 26, all that part of Section 33 lying north of the south right-of-way line of Highway 70A, the N/2 of NW/4 of Section 34, all of the north part of the NE/4 of Section 34 lying between the north line of said Section 34 and the south US 70 Highway right-of-way line, all of the north part of the NW/4 of Section 35 lying between the north line of said Section 35 and the south US 70 Highway right-of-way line, and beginning at a point on the south Highway US 70 right-of-way line, the same point being the Northeast Corner of Lot 668 of the Oak Ridge Subdivision, the same point also being the Northwest Corner of Tract 1 of said Subdivision, thence S0°40'07"E a distance of 464.39 feet, thence N89°07'38"E a distance of 707.51 feet, thence N0°40'07"W a distance of 86.27 feet, thence N89°07'38"E a distance of 262.5 feet to the West boundary of the Oklahoma State Wildlife property, thence North along said Oklahoma State Wildlife boundary to the south US 70 Highway right-of-way line, thence West along said south US 70 Highway right-of-way line to the point of beginning, all in Township 6 South, Range 6 East, Marshall County, Oklahoma.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the Town Council of Kingston, Oklahoma, this 10 day of October, 2000.


