

Ordinance # 2005-6

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY INTO THE CITY OF LANGLEY, OKLAHOMA, SUCH PROPERTY BEING GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS GRAND CREST ADDITION, MAYES COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Town of Langley, Oklahoma, a statutory municipality, desires to annex into its municipal limits, a subdivision within Mayes County, identified as Grand Crest, and

WHEREAS, notice has been duly posted and the matter has been properly set for public hearing before the Town Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS, the Town has received no protest or objections to such annexation, and

WHEREAS, such annexation is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Grand Crest subdivision of Mayes County, Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

The Town of Langley, Oklahoma, hereby annexes into its municipal limits all of Grand Crest subdivision located in Mayes County, Oklahoma, adjacent and contiguous to the Town of Langley, Oklahoma.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Town of Langley, Oklahoma shall forthwith commence providing municipal services to the annexed area including police and fire protection, road maintenance and improvement, E9-1-1 service, and further develop a plan for providing municipal utilities, water and sewer, as they become available.

IT IS SO ORDAINED on this 7th day of July 2005.
