


ORDINANCE NO.: 2004-3



An Ordinance extending the corporate boundaries of the Town of Laverne, Oklahoma, as to include the following described tract of real estate, and making the same subject to the jurisdiction thereof and declaring an emergency;

WHEREAS, **Patrick C. Hulin**, a single person, is the owner of the following described real estate, to-wit:

A tract of land situated in the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section 21, Township 26 North, Range 25 WIM, Harper County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Southwest Quarter of said Section, Township and Range, thence North along the East line of said SW/4 a distance of 203 feet; thence West a distance of 150 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 11 in Block 5 of Shuman's First Addition to the Town of Laverne, Oklahoma; thence South along the East line of said Lot 11 a distance of 170 feet to the Southeast corner of said Lot 11; thence continuing South a distance of 33 feet to the South line of said quarter section; thence East along the South line of said quarter section a distance of 150 feet to the point of beginning, containing .699 acres, more or less.

AND WHEREAS, it appearing to the Board of Trustees of the said Town of Laverne, Oklahoma, that all statutory requirements and notices have been completed and are all in due and legal form;


AND WHEREAS, said Town of Laverne, Oklahoma, in its discretion and within its jurisdiction deems it proper to increase said town limits for the benefit of said municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LAVERNE, HARPER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, in regular session assembled:


(1) That the above tract of land as designated be and the same is hereby annexed to and made a part of the Town of Laverne, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of the Town of Laverne, Oklahoma, be and are hereby extended so as to include said tract and the same is hereby made a part of and included within the corporate limits of said Town, and fully subject to the jurisdiction thereof.

(2) EMERGENCY CLAUSE: An emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which it is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety and welfare, and for the best interest of the public, that this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication, according to law.

# Laverne, Oklahoma Harper County




## Laverne
