

ORDINANCE NO. 02- 49

AN ORDINANCE DETACHING CERTAIN PARCELS OF LAND FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAWTON, OKLAHOMA, THEREBY ALTERING, DIMINISHING AND RE-ESTABLISHING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAWTON, OKLAHOMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Emergency Ordinance

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, finds it desirable to diminish the corporate limits of said city by detaching the hereinafter described parcels of land;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, finds that the detachment of said parcels of land will redound to the benefit of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, authority is vested in the City Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, pursuant to Title 11, Section 21-110, Oklahoma State Statutes, 1981, to detach territory from the corporate limits of said City of Lawton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, that:

SECTION 1. The following described tracts of land now included within the corporate limits of the City, to-wit:

The West half (W/2) of Section 17, Township 1 North (T1N), Range 12 West (R12W); and

The North thirty-three (33) feet of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of Section 20, Township One North (T1N), Range Twelve West (R12W), I.M., Comanche County, Oklahoma. (4.0 ac.); and

The East thirty-three (33) feet of the North thirty-three (33) feet of Section 19, Township One North (T1N), Range Twelve West (R12W), I.M., Comanche County, Oklahoma. (0.025 ac.); and

The East thirty-three (33) feet of Section 18, Township One North (T1N), Range Twelve West (R12W), I.M., Comanche County, Oklahoma. (4.0 ac.)

be and the same hereby are detached from the corporate limits of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. The limits or boundary of said property included within the corporate limits of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, as they are now constituted be and they are hereby altered, diminished and modified so as to exclude the above described property, and same shall henceforth and hereafter no longer be a part of the City of Lawton.



In order to preserve the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist whereby the provisions of this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


