AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ATTACHMENT OF A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND INTO THE CITY OF LAWTON, COMANCHE COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, CLASSIFYING SAID TERRITORY AS "TEMPORARY" I-1 (RESTRICTED MANUFACTURING AND WAREHOUSING DISTRICT) ZONING CLASSIFICATION FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING ONE (1) YEAR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Emergency Ordinance

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2006 the City of Lawton, Oklahoma received a request from the property owner, Lawton Industrial Foundation, Inc., that a tract of land located in Section 2, Township 1 North, Range 13 West, more particularly described in Section 1, be annexed into the corporate city limits of the City of Lawton.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, that:

SECTION 1. The city limits of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, shall constitute and be and include within the limits of said city the following described territory, to-wit:

Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of the East Half (E/2) of Section Two (2), Township One North (T1N), Range Thirteen West (13W), I.M., Comanche County, Oklahoma, according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof;

SECTION 2. The city limits of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma, are hereby extended to include for all purposes the above-described parcel of land.

SECTION 3. Said tract shall be zoned and classified as "temporary" I-1 (Restricted Manufacturing and Warehousing District) zoning classification for a period of time not exceeding one (1) year from the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. The Municipal Service and Implementation Plan pursuant to Oklahoma Statute, Title II, Section 21-103, is not necessary due to the fact that annexation was requested by a majority of the property owner.

SECTION 5. Emergency. Whereas, it being immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Lawton and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this ordinance be put into full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from and after its passage, as provided by law.
