AN ORDINANCE DETACHING TERRITORY FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MADILL. PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY.



BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Madill, Marshall County, State of Oklahoma:

SECTION 1: The following described property was annexed to the City of Madill, Oklahoma and the City desires to detach it from the corporate limits of the municipality in accordance with Title 11 Oklahoma Statutes § 21-110. Therefore the following described tracts of land are to be detached from the corporate limits of the City of Madill:

Tract One:

Lots 1 through 14 of Moore's Acres, Marshall County, Oklahoma

Tract Two:

That portion of Carolyn Street between Brenda and Sharon Ave. lying West of Lots 1 through 14 of Moore's Acres.

Tract Three:

A certain tract or parcel of land located in the SW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 28, Township 5 South, Range 5 East, described as follows:

Beginning at a point 154 feet East of the SW/Corner of the SW/4 of the SE/4 of the NW/4, Section 28, thence North 180 feet, thence North 180 feet, thence East 36 feet, thence North 45 East a distance of 70.71 feet, thence North 56.9 feet, thence South 76.23 feet East a distance of 46.3 feet, thence South 274.2 feet, thence West 131 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2:

Upon passage of the Ordinance, the Mayor of the City of Madill shall file and record a duly certified copy of the Ordinance, together with an accurate map or plat of the territory, in the office of the County Clerk of Marshall County, Oklahoma and with the Ad Valorem Division of the Oklahoma Tax Commission.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY. If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: EMERGENCY CLAUSE. An emergency is hereby declared to exist for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Madill, Oklahoma by reason whereof this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


