

ORDINANCE NO. 11-2001

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE INCORPORATED LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF MAYSVILLE, OKLAHOMA, SO AS TO INCLUDE AND INCORPORATE WITHIN THE INCORPORATED LIMITS OF SAID TOWN CERTAIN LANDS ADJACENT TO THE PRESENT LIMITS OF SAID TOWN.

WHEREAS, the the owner of more than 3/4ths in value of the property hereinafter described, and more than 3/4ths of the registered voters residing on said described property have presented to the Board of Trustees of the Town of Maysville, Oklahoma, a petition for annexation; and,

WHEREAS, said petitioner has given proper notice as required by law, prior to presenting said petition; and,

WHEREAS, said area is contiguous and adjacent to the present incorporated limits of Maysville, and it would be to the best interest of said petitioner and of the Town of Maysville for it to be so annexed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MAYSVILLE, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the incorporated limits of the Town of Maysville, Oklahoma, be, and they are extended so as to include within said incorporated limits of said town the following described real property, situated in Garvin County, State of Oklahoma, to wit:

That certain piece of land described as commencing at the Northwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 15, Township 4 North, Range 2 West of the I.B.M., Garvin County, Oklahoma, Thence East 208.75 feet; Thence South 417.5 feet, Thence West 208.75 feet; Thence North 417.75 feet, to the point of beginning, containing 2 acres, more of or less.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY: It being immediately necessary for the preservation for the public health, peace and safety of the Town of Maysville and its inhabitants that this ordinance become effective immediately, an emergency is hereby declared and found to exist and by reason whereof this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as by law provided.


